**Under this agreement for 2022  
Murgon State School will receive**

**\$155,889\***

## This funding will be used to

- Increase student attendance from 85% in 2021 to over 90%
- Ensure smooth transitions for all Prep students and Year 6 students into High School
- Continue a reduction in behaviour incident referrals (2718 in 2019, 1988 in 2020 & 1852 in 2021) and student disciplinary absences (127 in 2019, 86 in 2020 & 103 in 2021)
- Ensure all students demonstrate improvement in Reading through the use of Systematic Synthetic Phonics and Reading Screeners

## Our initiatives include

- Employment of a School Attendance and Community Officer who will be tasked with:
  - Increasing the yearly attendance to greater than 90% (88% in 2020, 85% in 2021)
  - Increase collaboration with external agencies (CCRAICHS, Cherbourg Council, CTC, etc)
- Employment of an additional teacher aide to increase student engagement through individualised support and transition to school programs
- Purchasing and training school staff in the Inclusive approach to the Teaching of Reading
- Purchasing systematic synthetic phonics materials and online training to ensure school wide implementation of this approach
